

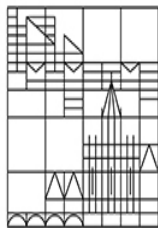
# Workshop "Weyl and the Problem of Space, from Science to Philosophy"

## Konstanz, May 27-29 2015

During this workshop, we aim to deal with the Problem of Space, as it has been developed by Hermann Weyl, both in its philosophical and scientific dimensions (cf. [joined detailed presentation text](#) ). This symposium is proposed by the Zukunftskolleg and the Department of Philosophy (University of Konstanz) and by Collège International de Philosophie (Paris), in partnership with CEPERC (Aix-en-Provence), and with the support of the "Pensée des Sciences" laboratory (ENS, Paris). The symposium will be divided in fourth parts:

- The mathematical side of the Space Problem
- The physical side of the Space Problem
- The Faces of Subjectivity in Weyl's thought
- Round Table: *Mathematische Analyse des Raumproblems*

The three first parts will be composed of 45minutes conferences, followed by a 15mn discussion.

The round table will be composed of 15-30mn conferences, followed by a long debate between the speakers and the public. It will be about the philosophical stakes of Weyl's monograph *Mathematische Analyse des Raumproblems*, in connection with the new commented French-German edition (Presses Universitaires de Provence).

Some advice if you come **from PARIS**: there are two natural ways by train, namely Paris-Strasbourg-Offenburg-Konstanz, and Paris-Zürich-Konstanz. You must allow a little more than 5 hours and a half.

Some advice if you come **from Provence**: by train, you are not compelled to go through Paris. You can use the line Marseille-Frankfurt and get off the train at Baden-Baden. Then, you have a train to Konstanz. By flight, there is no low-cost for Zürich from Marseille, but there some from Nice.
